



CHULA VISTA COMMUNITY COLLABORATIVE
PARTNERS MEETING MINUTES
June 14, 2016

1. Margarita Holguin welcome everyone and introductions were made
2. **San Ysidro Health Center Full Scope Medical**, Alejandra Garcia. Presented the new Medi-Cal expansion to all children regardless of immigration status, as long as they meet the income level guidelines. She mentioned the services included in Medi-Cal, explained retroactive services, the application process and how it affects families with children enrolled in Kaiser Child Health Plan, how it affects children that have never been in the MediCal system, and how it affects families with a child already in the system, and other benefits of the expansion. Alejandra also mentioned SYHC's is working on promotion of voter registration.
3. **YMCA Kinship Program**, Melissa Brooks. Has five programs to provide services to kinship givers. Kinship navigators provide case management and assist accessing to Medi-Cal and CalFresh, and child care; other programs include bilingual support groups, family events, and emergency funding and rased. YMCS Kinship takes referrals from outside agencies.
4. **Neighborhoods For Kids**, Dijana Beck. Purpose is to help children be safe from abuse and neglect. In the old model of service delivery, they would enroll the child in a different school in another area, causing added stress and trauma, now they make an effort to keep the child in the same community, school and neighborhood. They are now structured by regions or clusters, and sub region; are in the process of naming the clusters, forming key partnerships through relationships with the intent of surrounding the child with people that are familiar. The process will change in January 2017.
5. **San Diego County Health and Human Services Agency, CAPI**, Alma Andrade and Alicia Gonzalez. CAPI is a state cash aid program for blind and disabled individuals. They went over the eligibility guidelines for CAPI, eligibility verification, income guidelines, requirements, and application process.
6. **NAMI San Diego, Side by Side**, Cinthya Luis. Presented on how NAMI assists in the care and navigation of mental illness with a new program that bridges the gap of isolation associated with mental disease by matching or pairing the client with a companion that can be another mental health patient, a friend or a relative, or a mental health champion, similar to Big Brother Big Sisters model. Cinthya also explained the eligibility requirements. The pairing last a maximum of 6 months, and companions go through orientations, interviewing, and training.
