May 9, 2017**

1. Margarita Holguin welcomed everyone and introductions were made. Margarita announced there will be an Intergenerational Resident Leadership Academy on August 23rd at CV High School and they are looking for community members of all ages to participate. The application will be sent out in the next few days.
2. **Big Brothers Big Sisters**, Karla Mendoza. PowerPoint was provided, along with handouts. Karla shared information on the organization. Criteria, commitment, and benefits for being a mentor or a little brother/sister were shared. Information on their programs and initiatives was also provided.
